We are pleased to announce the inaugural Cold Spring Harbor Asia conference on Frontiers of Immunology in Health and Diseases which will be held at the Suzhou Dushu Lake Conference Center in Suzhou, China. The conference will begin on the evening of Sunday Nov. 7th, and will conclude on the evening of Wednesday Nov. 10th, 2010.

This conference is similar in design to the famous Cold Spring Harbor meetings series, a program now in its 75th year. The conference will include eight oral sessions and two poster sessions covering the latest findings across many topics in immunology in health and diseases. Many talks will be selected from the openly submitted abstracts on the basis of scientific merit and relevance.

Abstracts should contain only new and unpublished material and must be submitted electronically by the abstract deadline. Selection of material for oral and poster presentation will be made by the organizers.
