



Himeji Castle

Built in 17th century, Himeji Castle was the first in Japan to be registered as a UNESCO Cultural World Heritage in 1993.

It is called "Hakuro-jo" (White Heron Castle) because of its brilliant white exterior and supposed resemblance to a white heron taking flight.

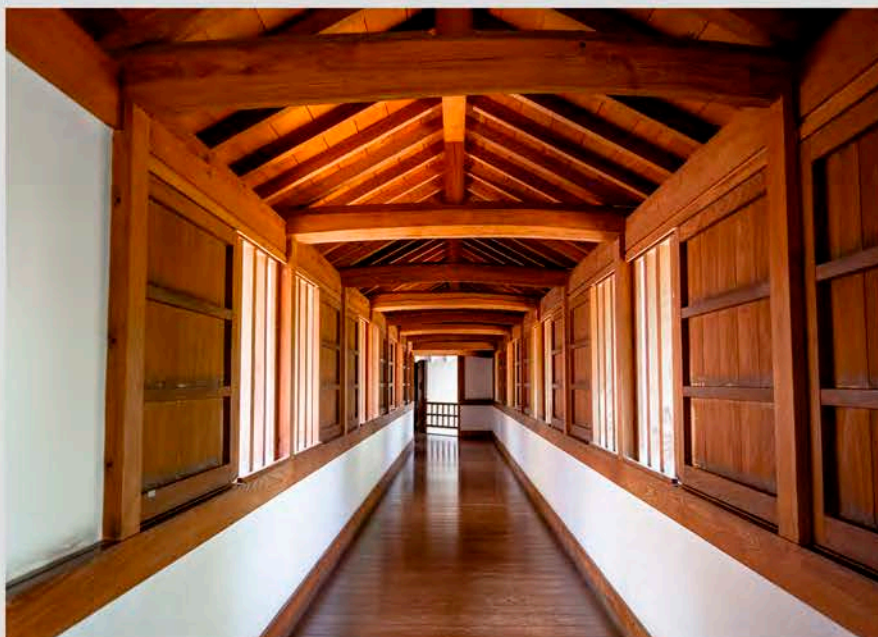
